The property is located at 3 Hillcrest Heights in the Conservation and Rural Districts in both the 2009 and proposed 2015 bylaws and owned by the Applicants.
2. Application of Northwestern Medical Center requesting Site Plan Approval in accordance with Sections 303, 315(7), 417 of the 2009 St. Albans Town Zoning Bylaws and Subdivision Regulations and Sections 404, 410, 803, 804 of the 2015 proposed Unified Development Bylaws. The property is located at 133 Fairfield Street in the Commercial/Residential District within a Designated Growth Center in both the 2009 and proposed 2015 bylaws and is owned by the Applicant.
