In accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 1972, the citizens of the Town of St. Albans are hereby notified that on September 6th, 2017, the Selectboard adopted the revised Street Addressing Ordinance. The purpose of the ordinance is to establish a more uniform street naming and addressing system throughout the Town of St. Albans and easily locatable address that will have a number of beneficial results.
